You are hereby advised of your right under Article V, Section 4 of the Credit Union's bylaws to submit to the Chairperson on or before December 31, 2025, a petition requesting your nomination as a nominee to the Credit Unions Board of Directors. Your petition must be signed by at least fifty (50) members eligible to vote at meetings of the members of the Credit Union. "If no member submits a petition, the chairperson shall take a voice vote to declare each nominee elected by acclamation at the annual meeting and there shall be no election by mail ballot."

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS DUE

Each year, TACU awards up to \$2,000 in scholarship money. The money can be given to an individual recipient or be divided among multiple recipients at the discretion of our scholarship committee.

### Eligibility Requirements:

The applicant must be a member or a child of a primary member of TACU and the applicant must be enrolled or plan to enroll in a school of higher education on a full-time basis for the 2026-2027 school year.

### Application Process:

The applicant must complete the TACU scholarship application, which can be printed from TACU's website at [www.tacuonline.com/scholarship](http://www.tacuonline.com/scholarship). Once complete, the application with one letter of reference and a resume should be submitted to TACU on or before March 14, 2026. The award(s) will be presented in May.
