Your petition must be signed by at least fifty (50) members eligible to vote at meetings of the members of the Credit Union. "If no member submits a petition, the chairperson shall take a voice vote or declare each nominee elected by acclamation at the annual meeting and there shall be no election by mail ballot."

Tips for Preventing Plastic Card Fraud



- **Consider Locking your Card, and ONLY unlock it when it will be used.**



Locking your debit card can prevent fraudulent attempts and unauthorized transactions, saving you from the hassle of disputing them. Download the Brella App now.



- **Be Cautious of Fake Websites, Links or Apps.**

Much of the current fraud is due to people clicking on fraudulent links or installing unsafe apps on their phones, which can lead to malware being installed on their device and their data being stolen for debit card fraud.



- **Set up Account Alerts.**

Setting up alerts through online banking or the Brella App can provide notification whenever your card is used or money is withdrawn from your account, giving you more control over your finances.

- **Check your Account Activity Often.**
